I am requesting funding for the 14th Ave Reimagined project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Seattle located at 600 4th Ave, Seattle, Washington, 98104.

Funding will be used to transform the primary north-south corridor in the South Park neighborhood of Seattle from a pedestrian-hostile chokepoint to a safe multimodal street. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it completes a critical missing link in a regional trail network stretching to Pierce County, while bringing safer street design to one of Seattle's most disadvantaged communities that currently lacks safe options for pedestrians and cyclists traveling through the neighborhood.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
