Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the South Park Water Quality Facility (SPWQF) project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Seattle located at 600 4th Ave, Seattle, Washington 98104.

The funding would be used to transform a nearly three-acre contaminated site along the Duwamish River into a new water quality treatment facility. The South Park Water Quality Facility (SPWQF) will treat polluted stormwater water from a 240-acre drainage area. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will benefit both human and environmental health in the Duwamish Valley. Through its two-step filtration system, the SPWQF will eliminate the risk of polluted stormwater re-contaminating the river.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
