Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Seattle Center Fisher Pavilion Revitalization project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Seattle, located at 600 4th Ave, Seattle, WA 98104.

Funding will be used to modernize the Fisher Pavilion's building systems through installing independent heating and cooling infrastructure, along with upgrades to electrical distribution, fire sprinklers, and fire alarms. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Fisher Pavilion serves as a designated emergency response facility, severe weather shelter, and is host to critical public health events. Modernizing this infrastructure will protect over 18,600 jobs and more than \$2 billion in annual economic activity that Seattle Center generates for the regional economy.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
