I am requesting funding for the Capital Repairs to Preserve Affordable Housing project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Community Roots Housing, located at 1620 12th Ave, Suite 205, Seattle, Washington 98122.

Funding will support capital improvements of four affordable housing properties in Seattle. The upgrades include exterior and systems upgrades, roof and window replacements, masonry tuckpointing, interior finishes, and elevator modernizations that address life, safety, and health improvements for residents. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will preserve existing affordable housing units, generate local construction jobs, prevent displacement of long-term residents, and ensure these properties continue delivering affordable housing to the community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4)
