Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Terminal 91 (T91) Substation 12 Replacement project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Port of Seattle located at 2711 Alaskan Way, Seattle, Washington, 98121.

Funding will be used to replace aging electrical substation infrastructure at Port of Seattle's Terminal 91, which powers critical cold storage, commercial fishing fleet operations, and cruise facilities that are central to Pacific Northwest food security and maritime supply chains. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because T91's electrical infrastructure is decades beyond its intended service life and currently at risk of failure. Operational failure would disrupt national seafood supply chains, maritime jobs, and regional economic stability.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 46 USC 54301.
