I am requesting funding for Seattle Repertory Theatre renovations in fiscal year 2022.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Seattle Repertory Theatre located at 155 Mercer St., Seattle, WA 98109.

The funding would be used for to bring the Theatre's primary and largest performance space up to current standards for the Americans with Disabilities Act and provide restrooms accessible to transgender and gender non-conforming people. The Seattle Rep is the largest nonprofit resident theatre in the Pacific Northwest. These renovations will improve access and equity for the 160,000+ patrons who attend 350+ performances and events in the Seattle Rep's facility in a typical year, including those produced by the organization as well as by other nonprofit organizations that rent or utilize the space for free.
