I am requesting funding for Shoreline N 175th Street Corridor Improvements Project (Phase 1) in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Shoreline, located at 2400 NW 80th St. #191, Seattle, WA 98117. The funding would be used to implement construction of sidewalks, pedestrian crossing and ADA improvements, bike lanes, transit improvements (including speed and reliability enhancements and a new bus stop), and a new signal system at N 175th and Meridian Ave N intersection.
